

## Maypearl Secondary School Motor Vehicles/Parking

### **Parking/vehicles on campus:**

All student vehicles must have a parking decal displayed in the front wind shield.

To obtain a parking decal student must provide:

- a valid drivers license,
- proof of insurance,
- license plate number and vehicle description,
- pay a \$20 fee for the school year, or \$10 per semester,
- parking agreement signed by student and a parent.
- parking decals are non-transferable between vehicles.

**No parking decals will be issued without all of the above information.**

### **Parking Regulations:**

It is considered a privilege to park on school grounds. Violations of parking/driving regulations may result in consequences up to and including: towing of vehicles, suspension of driving privileges, and/or suspension from school.

Vehicles parked on school property are under jurisdiction of the school. The school reserves the right to search any vehicle if reasonable cause exists to do so, with or without the presence of the student.. A student has full responsibility for the security of his or her vehicle and will make certain it is locked and that the keys are not given to others. A student will be held responsible for any prohibited objects or substances, such as alcohol, drugs, tobacco products, or weapons that are found in his or her car and will be subject to disciplinary action by the District, as well as referral for criminal prosecution.

For the convenience and protection of the student body, regulations concerning parking and driving on and around the school grounds are necessary:

- Students must park in designated student parking areas. Students may not park behind new athletic facilities or in spaces reserved for the Intermediate School.
- Students may not drive personal vehicles to the Ag Facility without special permission to do so from the principal.
- Students choosing to park on school property assume responsibility for all loss and damage.
- Students are expected to park, immediately exit the vehicle and enter the building.  
**Students are not allowed to remain in their vehicle after parking.**
- Students are not allowed to return to their vehicles during the school day. **Cars may not be moved after arriving at school until school is out unless the student has special permission to do so.**
- Pedestrians have the right-of-way at all times in the parking area.
- One tardy due to car trouble will be excused per semester.
- There will be no loitering in the parking lot at any time.
- Speed limit on campus is 10 mph.

- **There will be no speeding, or any form of reckless driving on the school grounds.** If a student is determined to have been careless, reckless or unsafe in driving, the student may be subject to disciplinary action, including revocation of parking/driving privileges, tickets, towing of the vehicle at the owner's expense, and/or other disciplinary action as deemed necessary by the principal.

Parking Violation/No Parking Permit:

- 1<sup>st</sup> offense-warning (detention if correction requires loss of class time)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> offense-loss of parking/driving privilege for one week
- 3<sup>rd</sup> offense-loss of parking/driving privilege for three weeks
- 4<sup>th</sup> offense-loss of parking/driving privileges for six weeks, vehicle may be towed

Reckless Driving/Excessive Speed:

- 1<sup>st</sup> offense-meeting with principal and notification of parents (detention if correction requires loss of class time)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> offense-loss of parking/driving privilege for one week, parents will be notified Failure to abide by this rule can mean suspension of the student.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> offense-driving privileges can be suspended for the entire year. Any serious violation could be in violation of the law and would thus be under the jurisdiction of law enforcement officials.
