



MISD staff is currently planning for a safe return on August 13, 2020. After polling our families and reviewing the TEA guidelines for re-opening, we will have two learning options for the 2020-2021 school year to meet the needs of our families. Students can participate in either on-campus learning or remote learning. **Beginning July 30, 2020, families will be asked to complete a commitment form to select one of the two options. The deadline to make the selection* is August 5, 2020.**

**Students will have the opportunity to change their preferred learning option, if necessary, at the start of each grading period.*

LEARNING OPTIONS

*Portions of plans are subject to change per TEA, state or local regulations surrounding COVID-19 prevention.

ON-CAMPUS

- 100% Face-To-Face Instruction
- Heightened cleaning and disinfection protocols
- Local and state health guidelines followed for face-to-face instruction
- Student participation in extracurricular activities as allowed by TEA, UIL and health officials
- Large groupings reduced throughout the day
- Face coverings required for 4th grade & up

REMOTE

- 100% Online Instruction facilitated by MISD Teacher
- Direct Instruction at scheduled times daily through TEAMS and/or recorded videos
- May be required to provide a device for each student
- Required to provide Internet access
- Daily required number of online learning minutes
- Required to take Universal Screener and State Assessments on campus
- Independent work required of students
- Grading policies and assignment due dates - same as on-campus learning
- Students not permitted to participate in extracurricular activities

SPORADIC CLOSURE PLAN: In the event of a long-term school closure due to COVID-19, MISD will transition to Remote Learning for all students.
