Dear Parents or Guardians,

Maypearl ISD started the 2021-2022 school year Thursday, August 12, 2021. We look forward to a positive and exciting school year. We wanted to share with you our updated plans for this school year concerning COVID-19:

- The district will continue to have hand sanitizer available in all classrooms and on buses.
- The district respects and welcomes students, staff or guests who choose to wear face coverings during the day. Face coverings should comply with all dress code requirements, including all facial hair requirements.
- The district will continue to sanitize rooms and buses weekly.
- Students are welcome to have sanitizer or sanitizing wipes at their desks to maintain a clean work area.
- Classrooms will have sanitizing spray and towels available for use.
- Students will continue to enter the building and go straight to their assigned classroom, only students eating breakfast will be in cafeterias prior to school starting.
- No Virtual School or Remote Learning option available, asynchronous or synchronously.
- No requirement of face coverings during school, on the bus or at events.
- No requirement of temperature checks as students enter the building.
- No quarantine requirements due to close contact and numbers of students or staff that report being infected with COVID-19 will be reported on the district website.
- The district will not be sending out letters each day when a student or staff member is reported. The data is for all to see on the district website. The letters created confusion and were generally not found to be very helpful.
- Students or staff will follow normal school health procedures to return to a campus.
- All attendance requirements will apply per local policy.
- Guest will be welcome on campus for teacher/parent meetings, other important meetings, or lunch. Only Parents or Guardians will be allowed to sit with their child(ren) at lunch. No other students will be allowed to sit with a student eating lunch with a parent or guardian. Siblings from other campuses or other family members are not allowed to participate. A designated area will be available in each cafeteria.
- All students and staff are recommended to bring a refillable water bottle for the day.
- All students, employees or campus visitors must self-screen before coming to school and take reasonable efforts to reduce spread of any illnesses.
