## **NOW ACCEPTING NOMINATIONS FOR GIFTED & TALENTED!!!**

It is that time of year again. We are beginning the process of identifying K-5<sup>th</sup> grade students in our district who qualify for the Gifted & Talented program. Maypearl ISD accepts the Texas Education Agency definition of gifted and talented students as stated below:

*A child or youth who performs at or shows the potential for performing at a remarkably high level of accomplishment when compared to others of the same age, experience, or environment, and who:*

- 1) exhibits high performance capability in an intellectual, creative, or artistic area,*
- 2) possesses an unusual capacity for leadership, or*
- 3) excels in a specific academic field*

We will begin accepting nominations from teachers, parents, and/or community members for student participation in gifted and talented. Students nominated will be assessed, upon written parental consent, to determine their eligibility for the program. Parents will then be notified of students' test results.
